

Anti Ragging Policy

Ragging is a social menace and is strictly prohibited in the Indian Academy Group of Institutions, its hostels, playgrounds and college premises. The top management of the Indian Academy Group of Institutions in association with the 'Anti-Ragging Committee' consisting of members representing college Governing Council, teachers, non-teaching staff and students takes many initiatives to prevent ragging.

The offence of ragging is not only punishable under Section 116 of the Karnataka Education Act, 1983, but also under various provisions envisaged in several sections of Indian Penal Code, 1860. Students involved in such obnoxious practices will be liable in addition to prosecution before the criminal courts, for rustication, dismissal and expulsion from the college.

Our Faculty

We have over 140 best teaching faculty at Lecturer, Senior Lecturer, Associate Professor, and Professor levels in over 25 departments. Our recruitment and selection policy is to attract the talent, compensate adequately and retain the best. The faculty members are greatly powered by:

Our Resources

Laboratories, Seminar Halls and Lecture Halls

We are located in three premises on Hennur Main Road, Bangalore. Our laboratories, lecture halls and seminar halls are spacious and well lit with good ventilation. All lecture halls have functionally designed modern furniture. Educational aids like slide projectors, overhead projectors, computers, televisions, LCDs, VCRs, CD players, Smart boards etc. are judiciously interfaced to make learning simple and easy. We extensively use ICT to communicate with our stakeholders. These technologies help to process and update on real time with greater precision and to generate various customized reports like individual students attendance, academic progress report, students feedback, faculty performance evaluation, etc.

We provide a full array of scientific and professional laboratories to our students and faculty so that they can have access to the latest technologies. Our computer science lab is equipped with computers having the latest hardware configuration. All the systems are in a networked environment whose hardware and software are continuously upgraded in tune with our requirements and changes in computing technology.

Our other department laboratories covering Biotechnology, Microbiology, Chemistry, Biochemistry, Genetics, Zoology, Physics, Electronics, Psychology subjects are well designed and adequately equipped. The laboratories are designed and equipped for students and faculty to engage in interdisciplinary research projects. Students have ample opportunities to use laboratory facilities both for structured practical sessions as well as for special workshops with hands-on training. Laboratory batches are small and individual attention is the rule, not exception.









Library

Our main library located in the new campus is spread over 2nd and 3rd floors with state of the art furniture. The library has an elegant array of Indian and foreign books, journals, magazines, encyclopedias, dictionaries etc. All the operations of library are computerized. Each floor of the library has adequate number of computers with broadband internet browsing facilities. In addition, photocopying facility is also available within the library. Through collaborations, associations and memberships inter library loan facilities are also arranged. At present these facilities are available with British Council Library and Bangalore University library.

In addition to the main library, there are independent libraries for our PU College and College of Nursing. Indian Academy PU College library has a vast collection of books and journals meant for PU level students and teachers. The College of Nursing library has a good collection of text books, reference books, and magazines besides national and international journals in the field of nursing and health sciences.

RGUHS-Helinet

Indian Academy College of Nursing is a member of Health Science Library and Information Network (HELINET) conceived by the Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore.

A consortium was started with a vision to improve the quality of education and research in the health science institutions of the State of Karnataka through enhanced access to high quality medical information. HELINET's goal is to deliver information to user's desk-top, with round-the-clock access.

Through HELINET we can access and share the contents in more than 600 journals in medical, dental, pharmacy, physiotherapy, nursing and paramedical subjects. RGUHS-HELINET uses the following gateways for accessing information: Science Direct, Ovid, MD Consult, Annual Reviews, Springer, Thieme Verlag, Taylor & Francis, Blackwell, Bentham, ebrary and Oxford University Press.



Extra Curricular Activities

Sports

The Department of Physical Education, with two well qualified and experienced Directors of Physical Education, offers training and coaching to students and employees in various games and sports. The department has both indoor and outdoor games and sports facilities to cater to the varied needs of students and employees. Apart from regular training and coaching activities, intra and intercollegiate competitions are conducted regularly. Selected students are further coached and trained for inter university competitions. Many of our students are selected to play for Pre-University Board, Bangalore University and Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences. We also host inter-collegiate and inter-university meets. Annual Sports Day is celebrated as a special event, with the participation of celebrities of various sports and games as guests of honour.

National Social Service - NSS

Student Support

Placement Division

Indian Academy Group of Institutions Placement Division (IAGI-PD) is established for training, development and placement of undergraduate, postgraduate students of IAGI. The primary objectives of IAGI-PD are to:

- Provide suitable placements for UG & PG students
- Organize training and skill development programs to students
- Provide placements for Summer Internship Programs and allied training activities
- Arrange job fairs and other on-campus recruitment drives
- Liaise with recruiters and employers
- · Guide students in off-campus placements

Both undergraduate and postgraduate students are encouraged to take up short term research projects and/or Internships in reputed research institutions, universities, public/private companies and business establishments.

Internships are short term duration and students rotate in various key departments of an organization. This will facilitate students to experience real time working atmosphere. Preparation of Internship Report helps students to collect, compile, analyze and present data as useful information. This experience helps students to present their work with greater confidence and conviction.

Internships are mandatory for some students (for example, BBM, BCA, MBA) but in general every student irrespective of their stream of education is encouraged to take up research projects and/or internships.

Student Support

International Students Cell

We are the preferred choice of many foreign students. We have students from Sri Lanka, Bhutan, Nepal, Thailand, South Korea, Ivory Coast, Uganda, Rwanda, Nigeria, Tanzania, Saudi Arabia, Sudan, Iran, Algeria, Oman etc. Our International Students Cell assists foreign students with documentation work in admission, VISA formalities, registration with residential permits at India, in housing arrangements, renewal of VISA, etc.

Student Mentor Program

Under this programme, a group of students are assigned to a dedicated faculty for the entire academic year for guiding and mentoring. The concerned faculty member takes up the responsibilities to assist students in achieving goals through periodical personal interactions and counseling.

Financial Aid

Indian Academy Educational Trust also offers merit scholarships and social welfare scholarships to the deserving students.

Merit Scholarships

The merit scholarship programme is an endeavour to boost the morale of meritorious students who have brought glory to themselves and the institute. The scholarship inspires the toppers to pursue their dream and strive for further excellence in their chosen field.

A student who is the topper in the test to be conducted by the IAGI in the first year of his/her course shall be awarded the merit scholarship for that year of the course; the topper in the university/Board examinations of the first year of his/her course (both semesters put together in the case of semester system) shall be awarded merit scholarship in the second year of the course and the topper in the university examinations of the second year of his/her course (both semesters put together in case of semester system) shall be awarded merit scholarship in the third year of the course.

Social Welfare Scholarships

The Indian Academy stands not just for academic excellence; it also creates a platform to students from economically weaker sections of the society to better their life through quality education without much worry of their finances. Social Welfare Scholarships shall be awarded to the students belonging to lower income group families. The students while studying in their first semester of courses in the IAGI are eligible for this scholarship. If a student in his/her first semester/year of his/her course is selected as per the guidelines framed by the IAET, then he/she shall be paid the scholarship amount every semester/year till the completion of the course



Students are also extended partial or full tuition fee waiver facility based on their merit/socio-economic status.

Citations and Prizes

Students with achievements in academics and extracurricular activities are recognized as best outgoing students with citations as well as cash prizes.

Extended Learning Avenues

Language Laboratory

A state of the art language laboratory equipped with computers and driven by sophisticated software for different languages is a place for those who desire to improve their language skills.

The program for English language called WORDS WORTH is being used in our language laboratory. It is a unique language program that enables the participant to communicate in English with clarity and confidence. It offers the best, in terms of continuous evaluation, content, teaching expertise, and methodology. The methodology is a blend of instructor lead training with a computer based learning. practice and evaluation. It gives the learner the best grounding in the finer nuance of the language. The focus areas are: speech sounds, pronunciation, Indianism, listening, grammar, speech fluency, vocabulary and idea formation. Using this great infrastructure facility, programs for other Indian and foreign languages are also contemplated to be in place soon.

Commerce & Business Management Laboratory

A separate laboratory equipped with information and communication technology hardware and software is established for the benefit of commerce and management students. Students use this laboratory to get additional training in select areas along with exposure to financial software, database management and networking.

Workshops

Short term training programs on selected core areas which are not emphasized in the prescribed curriculum are offered to students of various disciplines. These workshops are designed to enrich students' knowledge and skills and augment their employability. A few examples of such workshops are:

- Short term training in laboratory techniques {ex. DNA finger printing,) fermentation technology, plant and animal cell cultures, immunological techniques, karyotyping in humans etc) are offered for life science students.
- Workshops on end user computer applications are conducted for staff and students.
- Career avenues and skill development for students of commerce and management
- Production technique in film making for students of journalism
- Personality development & employment empowerment training for all students
- New trends and developments in management, logistics and supply chain management, customer relationship management for MBA students

Admission Procedure

- Foreign students receive bonafide provisional admission certificates and expenditure certificates and other relevant Documentation needed for obtaining student VISA from Indian Consulate offices at their respective countries.

- Upon fulfilling the admission formalities students are provided with college identification card and permitted to attend classes.
